A Quick Daily PuzzleBy Bando26I am rewriting my review now that I have gone through half the puzzles in the calendar.This calendar is full of good, often quick brainteasers. The difficulty varies from nearly obvious to downright challenging or obscure. Most puzzles orient the words in relation to each other to convey a common phrase. One of my favorite examples reads "clever emoc"; if you ponder the word "emoc", you'll realize that it's "come" spelled backwards, so the correct solution is "clever comeback."If you are very familiar with common English phrases and idioms, you might find yourself realizing the answer to some riddles within a second, simply from the words provided in the puzzle. For example, one puzzle reads "DOOR POLICY" and I immediately guessed the phrase "open-door policy" even before noticing that the D in "door" has its lines a bit disconnected (open). What other common phrase would have "door" and "policy" in it?Some of the more challenging puzzles are due less to the presentation of how the phrase is depicted in the puzzle and more to the obscurity of the phrase chosen. "Points in the paint," a basketball term, is one example that comes to mind. (I admit I'm not a basketball fan.) Another was "Pelican Brief", which is a book and movie from the early '90s. (Most coworkers weren't familiar with this either due to their younger age or the fact that the movie was forgettable.)My middle school history teacher used to put these sorts of puzzles on the whiteboard every morning and it was always a joy to try to be the first to solve them. It is fun to play

these types of puzzles again. I have the calendar on my desk at work and my coworkers often swing by to see if they can figure them out.
