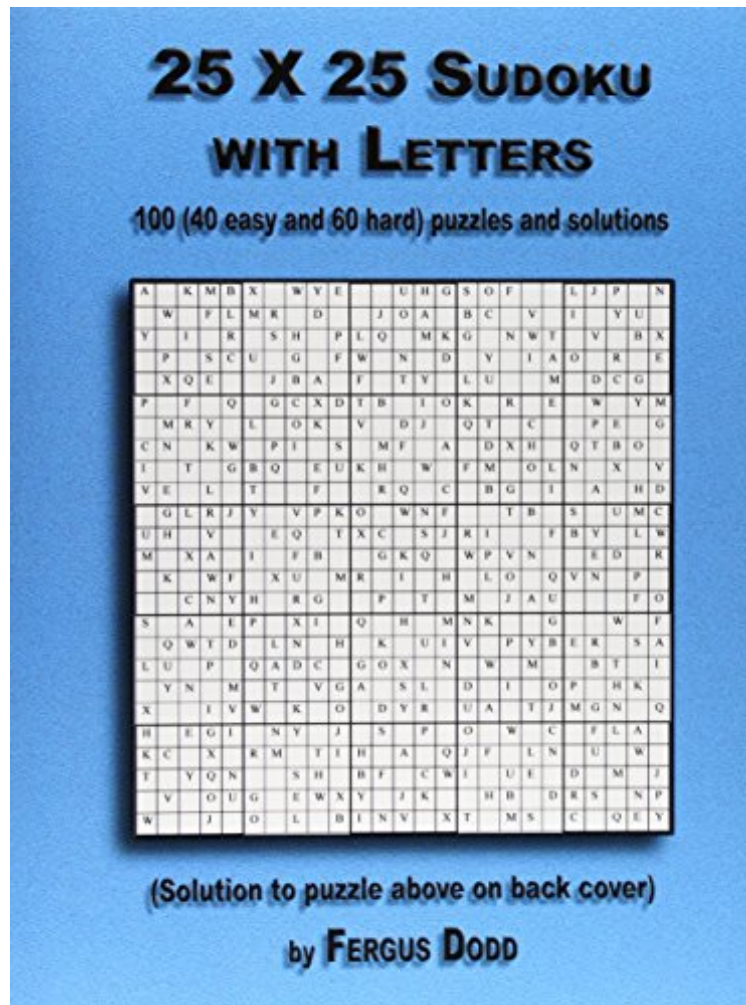

I'm only up to puzzle number 25 and 17 of the past puzzles have errors in them. At first there were only one or two errors in the puzzles but lately, it's entire rows of duplicate letters. You spend more time correcting the puzzles and answer pages than you do in trying to work the puzzles. Also, there is a lot of duplication in letter patterns. I couldn't find a publisher's address anywhere in this volume or I'd complain to them so I think this author may have published it on his own. If you don't mind correcting all the errors as you go along, then buy this book. There are other Sudoku books out there that have no errors and are much cheaper so you're better off buying those.1 of 1 people found the following review helpful. Typo errorsBy H. hoping to find more of a challenge. None of the puzzles are all that difficult but are time consuming as expected. After I had completed about 10, I ran into one with misprints (2 "h"s in one square). The next 5 puzzles also had typos and the solution pages do not correct the typos. Hemphill Similar to the other two reviewers, I had purchased this book to give myself more of a challenge. The first 5 were okay, but then EVERY SINGLE PUZZLE has a mistake in it. (duplicate letters in the rows/boxes). Since there was not even an email address listed anywhere, only a snail mail address in England, I wrote to the "author" and complained. Never heard a thing. (Didn't really expect to, but still...) There are online 25x25 games that you can download or print. Stick with those. You won't get as frustrated.

"Bored with conventional sudoku? Then 25x25 sudoku with letters is for you. 25x25 sudoku requires the player to fill in all the letters of the alphabet, except Z, into every row, column and all 25 boxes. It can be played by a novice, by an experienced sudokuer or by students of english who want a fun way to learn the english alphabet. It may look complex and take longer than ordinary sudoku, but it is easier than it looks, honest. You can have a free trial by printing off the sudoku puzzle and its solution on the preview. Enjoy".
