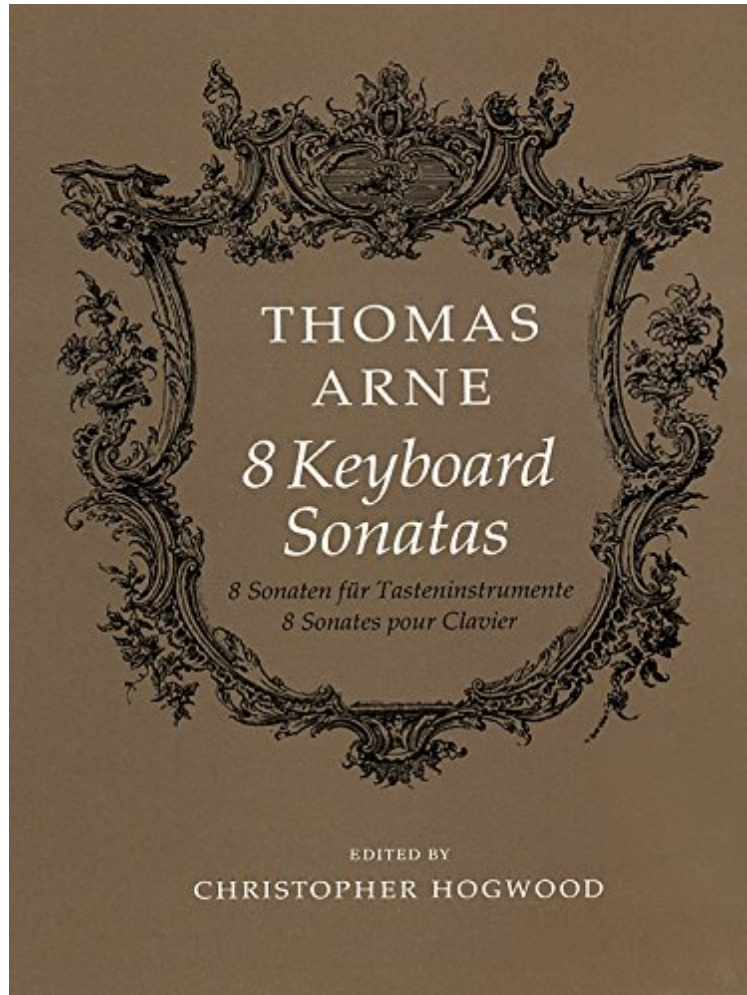

I didn't learn that from my musical education; I learned that from working crossword puzzles. For some reason, Arne's name is a favorite among puzzle designers. That's why I became curious about Arne's other compositions and checked this score out at the local library. I wasn't disappointed. This edition offers a very nice assortment of nuggets, including some slow ariettas, some sixteenth-note perpetual mobiles, two sets of minuet variations, a siciliano, a gavotte, and a fugue. Most of the first movements are in the rounded binary form. These sonatas can serve as recital pieces for the intermediate pianist or sightreading practice for the advanced pianist. A

complete performance takes about an hour and fifteen minutes. Perhaps Arne deserves some attention in the music studio, as well as on the puzzle page.
