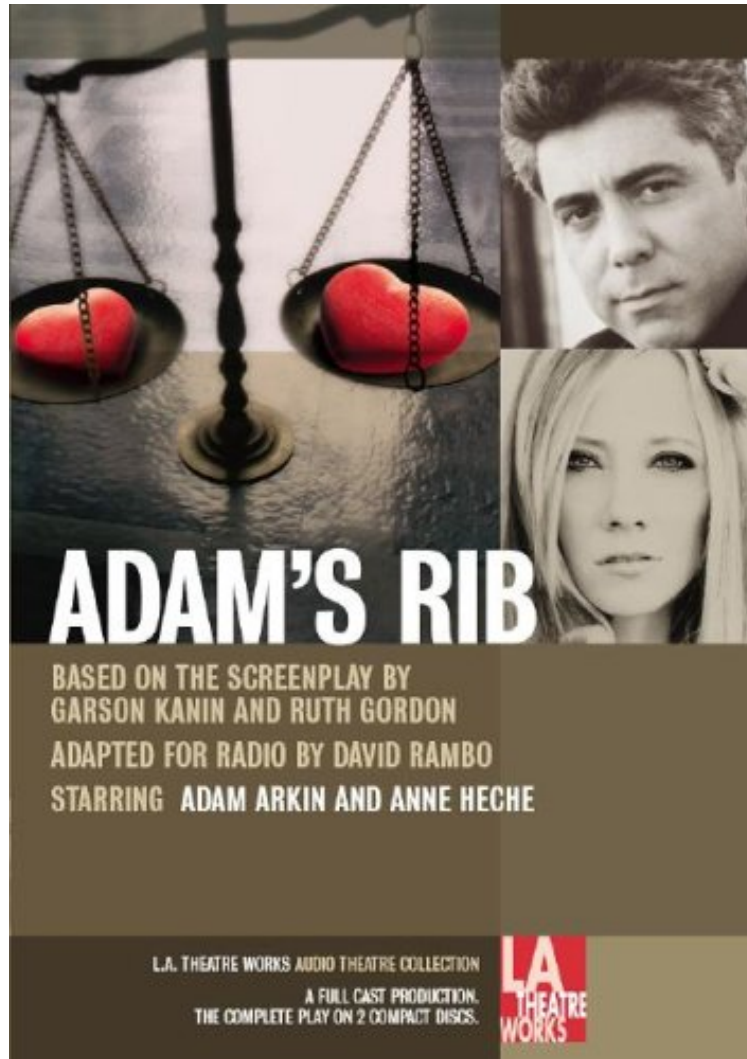

You never heard such a whiny, grating airhead - eyuk! No woman lawyer on earth sounds like this. If she'd just used her normal voice it would have been fine - it's the classic trying-too-hard-to-be funny. The other actors are all pretty good, but if the main character is unbearable it's hard to listen to without being continually annoyed. My advice: skip this and re-watch the movie instead.
