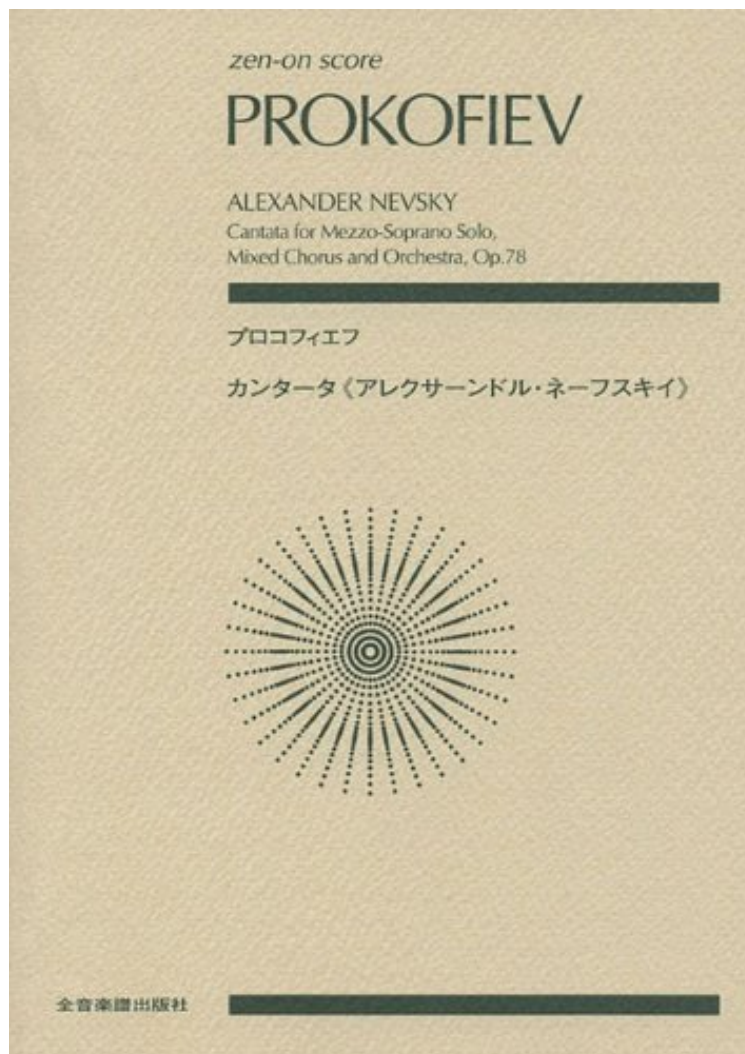

All of the instruments are in concert C, so you don't need to transpose the horns, trumpets, etc. to see what is happening harmonically. There is an interesting biography with notes on the writing and recording of the original score, in English and Japanese. Some of the instruments have cryptic names for this English speaker ("T-ro," etc.), but there is a key at the beginning. The score is a bit small on the page but readable for my 42-year old eyes. This is an interesting score to study for film composers. "Battle on the Ice" has 'influenced' many action cues, and some

parts are directly cut-and-pasted into Star Trek II. I'm not sure if I'd recommend this as the first score for someone to study, but you have to start somewhere.
