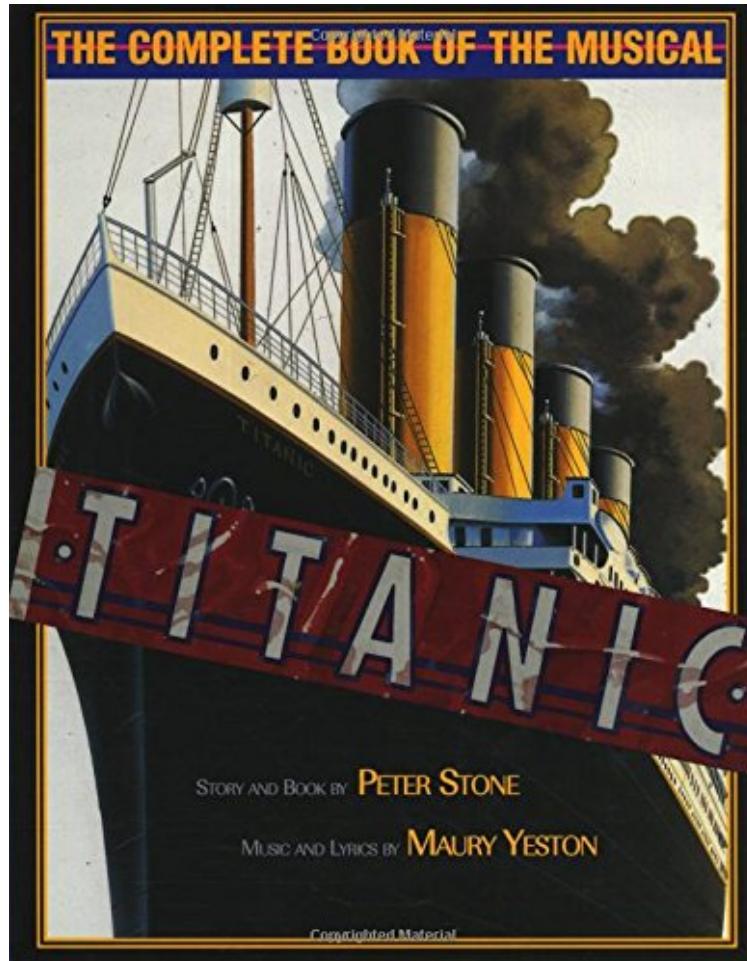

A thorough guide to the Broadway musical "Titanic" By ChemComposer This book is a cross between a coffee table "pretty" book and an illustrated libretto of the musical. The page size is 8 1/2 by 11 inches. First there are three sections about the musical and its birth: essays with photos by the story and book writer Peter Stone, and the composer of music and lyrics Maury Yeston; and the scenic and costume designer Stewart Laing provides several captioned drawings but no other text. Together these interestingly and engagingly cover those aspects of the Broadway production. Following these is the complete libretto with many photographs from the musical as it unfolds. At the end is a list of those who perished. There is no music as such with the book, printed or recorded. The book lacks three things I wish it had. First, the photographs of the unfolding story

have no identification of the characters in them and, when the lyrics and spoken words on a particular page come from two successive scenes, which scene the photo shows is not stated. Secondly, the list of the perished does not identify which persons were passengers and which were crew. Last, I wish the director and producer had also contributed essays to those the book has. This is a desirable book for those interested in how the Broadway musical came to be and those wanting its photographically illustrated libretto.
