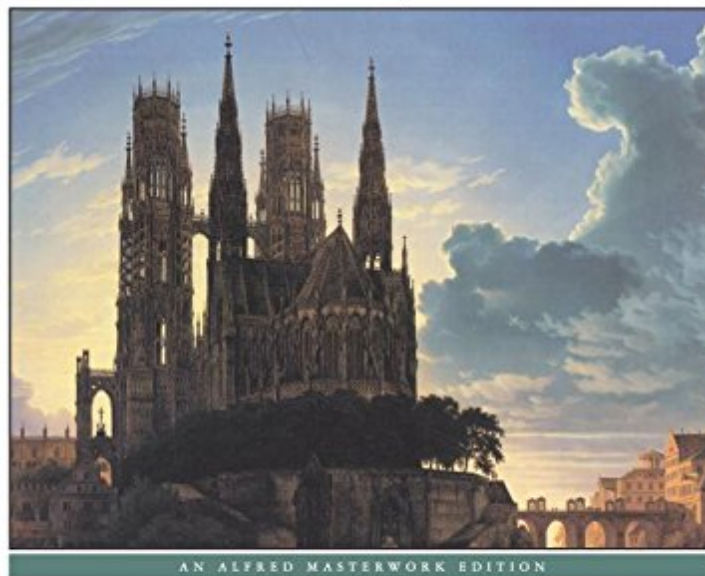

It represents a unique gem from Bach that is recognized by nearly everyone.The booklet provides exceptionally fine print with somewhat over-sized notes with detailed fingering. BWV 565 for the keyboard is presented in a fine style that is not as grandiose as Ferruccio Busoni but (in my opinion) much more

elegant and refined.
