There is a great variety of songs, all written in easy-to-sing keys, and with beautiful arrangements. Someone mentioned that some of these songs were too low, but I did not find that to be the case. The title does clearly say that these songs are written in low keys. The ranges of the songs are perfect for altos. If anything, some of the songs have occasional notes that go up to upper C or D (a bit high for me), but certainly nothing too low for a true alto.If you are an alto, and if you love the standard torch songs of yesterday, you will be absolutely thrilled with this songbook.
