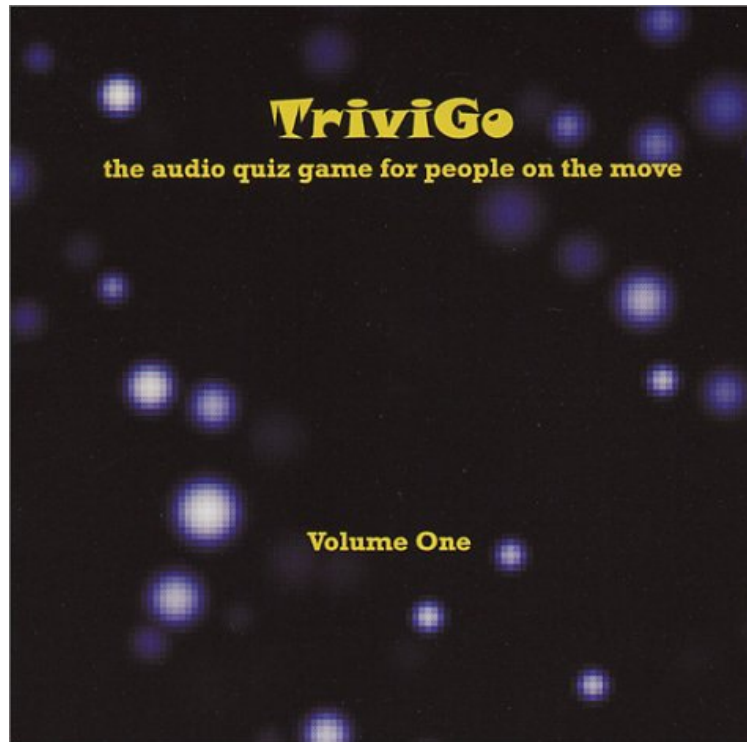

My husband and I saved this CD for a long car ride and found it difficult. We were a little disappointed. Great concept, though. I wish there were more available with specific topics.

Quiz show fans can now get their trivia "to go." People who enjoy learning general facts and playing trivia games are usually limited either to watching television or reading books. However, in these busy times, we are often in a car, waiting in line, or doing various physical activities places where TVs and books are simply not convenient. TriviGo makes it possible to take your quiz games anywhere you can take a CD player. TriviGo contains over seventy minutes

of general knowledge questions and answers. Each of the six audio games on TriviGo lasts about twelve minutes. After hearing a question, the listener has about five seconds to come up with the correct answer before the announcer reads it. Players can keep track of how many questions they get right, and chart their progress over time. There is a good mix of difficulty in the questions we wanted it to reward repeated listening, but to be fun, too. Almost anyone is sure to learn new facts by using TriviGo repeatedly. It is a good way to practice to be a quiz show millionaire, or simply to keep your memory in shape.
