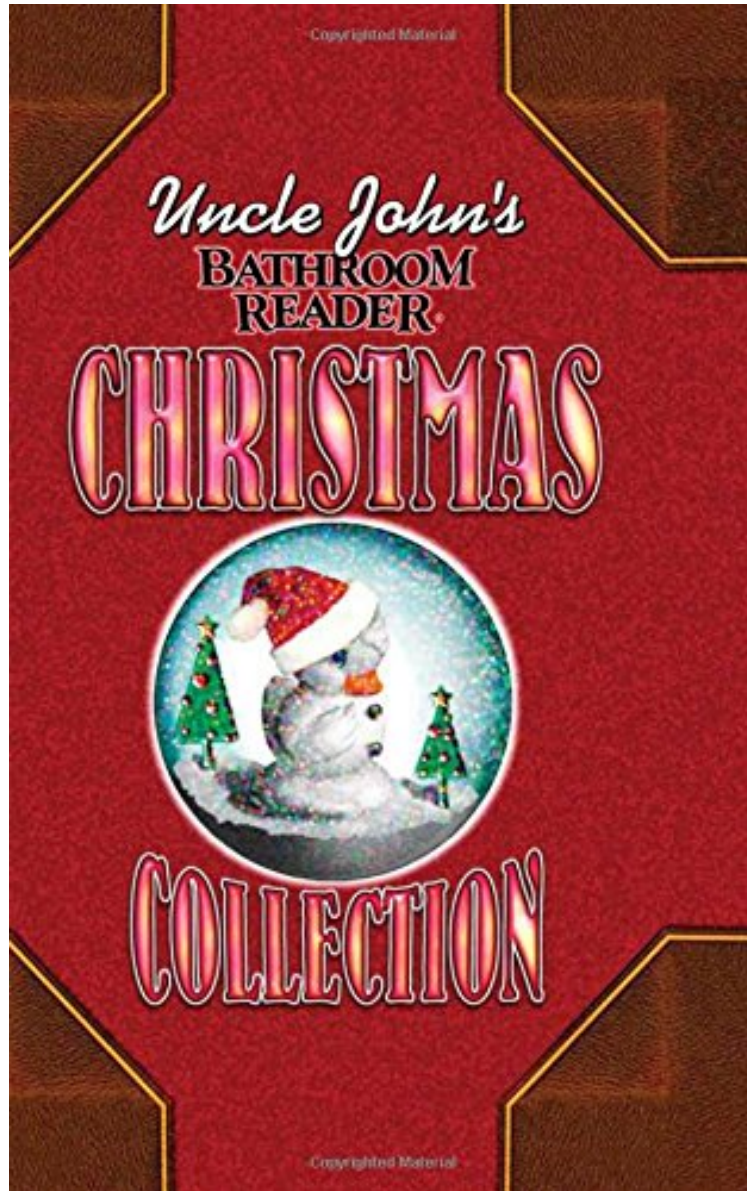

The chapters are designed to be read out of sequence, or certainly from cover to cover. Some of the series frankly stretch the premise quite a bit-this one definitely doesn't, and is probably THE best if not one of the best books in the series. In fact, one could say, and I will, one of the best "Christmas Fact" books in print. The series concentrates on popular culture, and that seems to be the emphasis in this book: Hot toys from the 70s-90s, Seinfeld-yup Festivus is in here etc. Since what most Americans anyway consider Christmas "traditions" are in fact only 100 years old or less-this isn't too far off the mark.
