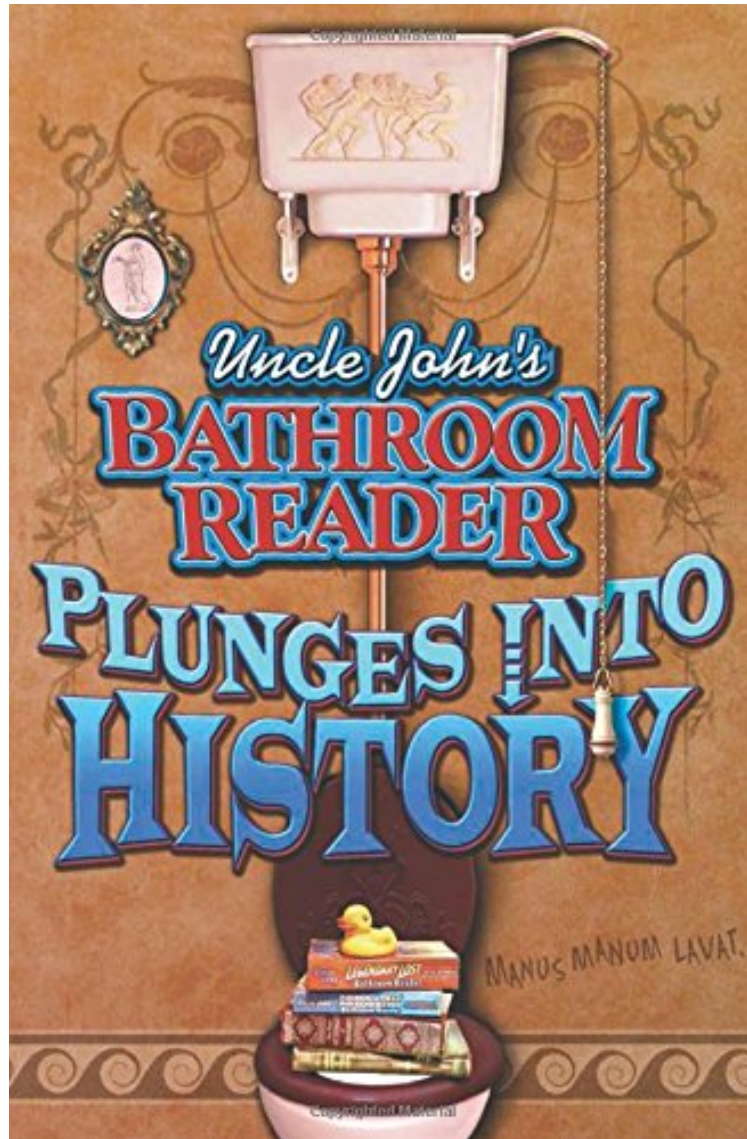

Rowcliffe I always buy one of Uncle John's Bathroom Readers for my husband at Christmas. We both enjoy them. The five stars are for the book, which is interesting and entertaining, as all UJBRs seem to be. I purchased this for my Kindle, though, and I don't like it nearly so well. I use a bit larger font than the default font. so maybe that is part of the problem, but all of the nice little bits of information that are on the bottom of each page in the printed book show up in random places on the Kindle page--I assume where the print page would have ended were it a book. There are no lines or other indications to separate these bits of information from the text of the anecdote, so I'll be reading an anecdote and suddenly there is a random bit of information, as if it were a part of the anecdote, and then the anecdote picks up again. It is very distracting. I find that I like to open the printed Bathroom Reader randomly and browse the topics. Can't do it easily on the Kindle, which sort of forces the reader into reading from the beginning to end. There is a good table of contents, but it's not that easy to go back and forth from table of contents to text. UJBRs don't fit well on the Kindle. Uncle John's Bathroom Readers are the best there is in this niche. For me, a lot of the pleasure of reading them lies in being able to flip through them and reading whatever catches my interest at the moment.
