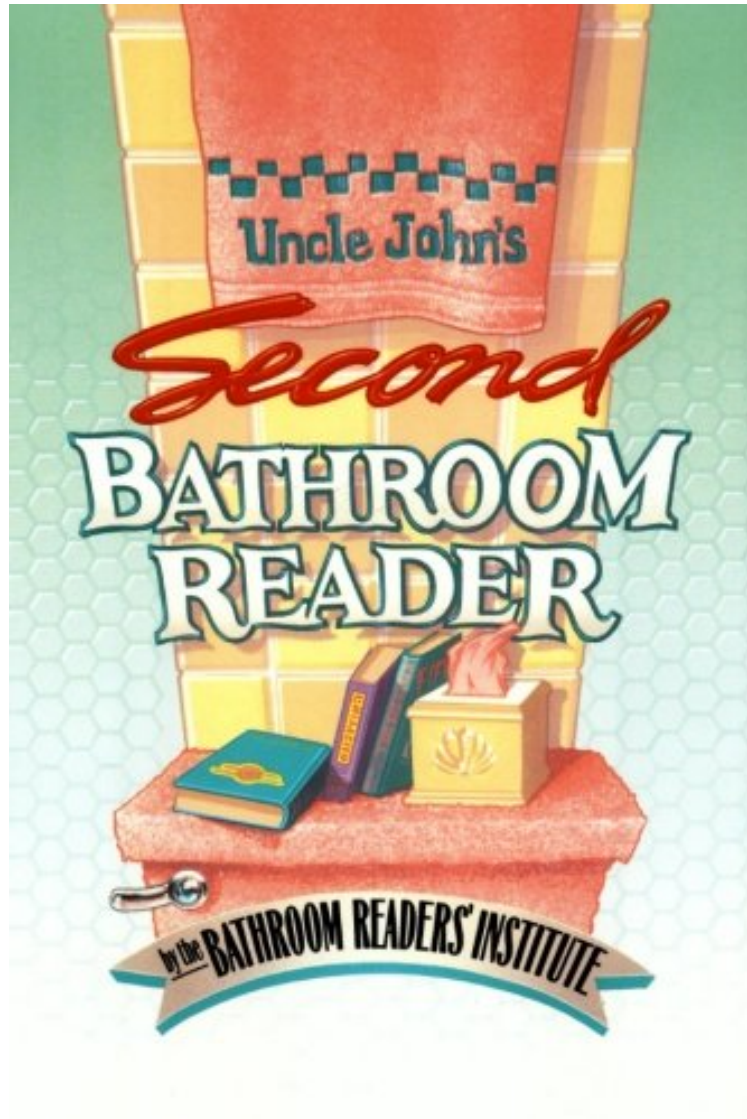


Uncle John's Second Bathroom Reader
