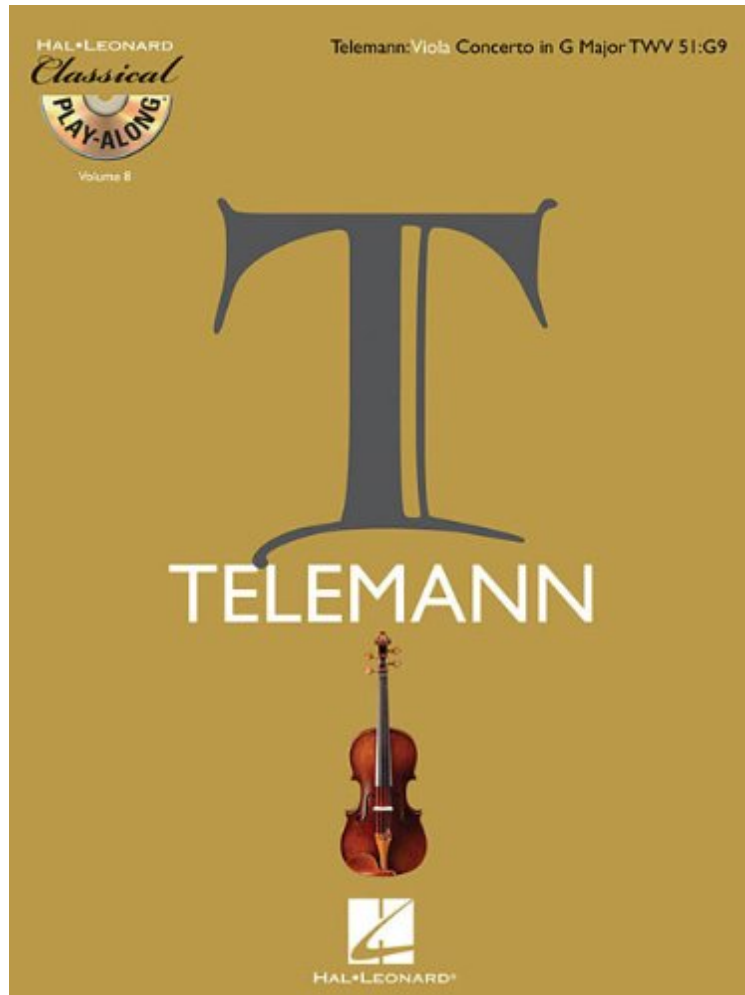

The CD comes with a full demonstration as well as a play-along orchestral version w/o the solo part. You can also slow the tempo down, which is handy since the original tempo is quite brisk. However, the movements are divided into several tracks and there is a pause between tracks which interrupts the flow of the movement. I communicated this to Hal Leonard and they sent me a corrected CD that has no gaps during the movements, which also includes two

piano accompaniment versions in addition to the orchestral one. The piano tracks come with a slow and faster version. You may want to check to make sure they have corrected this on subsequent orders or count on having to make this request if you like the accompaniment track idea. Another reviewer said there were cuts, but I haven't found that to be true. However, you may want to also get the Primrose edition which adds the tutti sections to the solo part as well as some nice written-out ornamentation in the slow movements. 1 of 1 people found the following review helpful.
